# Keynote Speaker - Ross Bernstein

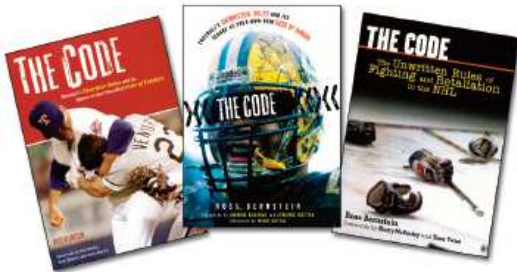
Motivational Speaker & Best-Selling Sports Author
